As you are aware, Indian Cyber Crime Coordination Centre is one of the schemes under Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India for prevention of cybercrimes through various stakeholders in a coordinated manner. In one of the verticals of I4C i.e. National Cybercrime Ecosystem Management Unit, it is enjoined to create an ecosystem for prevention of cybercrimes. Judicial training in cybercrime and electronic evidence is a multidisciplinary and practical type of training, essentially intended for the transmission of professional techniques and values complementary to legal education.

- To understand the fundamentals of cyber safety, current scenario, security goals, nature and composition of cyber space and its misuse for committing technological crimes and cybercrime prevention techniques.
- To ensure network security and develop understanding on actual infrastructure and manpower requirement.

- To understand the legal implications of the cyber space.
- To discuss the latest cybercrime cases, case law, forensic tools and investigation procedure.
