Subject: Regarding Divisional Judicial Seminar & Refresher Training Program on New Criminal Laws of all Judicial Officers posted in **Durg Division (Distt. Durg/Balod/Bemetara/Kawardha/Rajnandgaon)** scheduled to be held on **11/04/2026 (Saturday)** at **Durg**.

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On the subject cited above, it is to inform you that as per approved Calendar of Academy for the year 2026-27, a Divisional Judicial Seminar (**Physical**) & Refresher Training Program on New Criminal Laws of all Judicial Officers of **Durg Division (Distt. Durg/Balod/Bemetara/Kawardha/Rajnandgaon)** including those posted in Family Courts and on deputation (except those nominated for other Workshops/ Seminars/ Training Programs as well as engaged in urgent work/remand duty) will be organized on **11/04/2026 (Saturday)** at **Durg**. (Venue is to be selected by the Principal District & Sessions Judge, Durg) on the following topics:

- 1. The doctrine of competency of Court under Order 7 Rule 10 CPC. The power to reject a plaint at the threshold under Order 7 Rule 11 CPC- A Judicial duty or Discretionary power. (For- Rajnandgaon District)**
- 2. Expediting execution-Strategies for speedy disposal with special reference to Periyammal (dead) through Legal Representatives and others vs. Rajamani and another (Civil Appeal Nos. 3640-3642 of 2025 (arising out of SLP(c) Nos. 8490-8492 of 2020) and overcoming execution hurdles. (For- Bemetara District)**
- 3. An overview of procedure for cases under Section 138 Negotiable Instruments Act. Innovative tools and techniques for disposal of cases under Section 138 Negotiable Instruments Act. (For- Balod District)**

4. The purpose, Admissibility and Evidentiary value of examination of accused under Section 351 BNSS (Section 313Cr.P.C.). Admissibility and Evidentiary value of statements under Section 180 BNSS (Section 161 Cr.P.C.) and confessions/statements under Section 183 BNSS (Section 164 Cr.P.C.) (For- Kabirdham District)

5. An overview of e Sakshya with reference to newly statutory mandates. Admissibility mandates of e Sakshya under Section 63 BSA. (For- Durg District)

It is, therefore, requested to inform all Judicial Officers posted under your jurisdiction including those posted in Family Courts and on deputation (except those nominated for other Workshops/Seminars/Training Programs as well as engaged in urgent work/remand duty) for the above said Seminar/Training. They may be directed to report on **11/04/2026 (Saturday) at 09.30 am** at the venue selected by the Principal District & Sessions Judge, Durg. They shall wear decent attire i.e. sober colour Shirt, Trouser, Coat & Tie for male officers and sober colour Saree or Suit with coat for the female officers.

As directed, it is further requested to kindly inform all participating Judges of your Establishments that :

- (i) The topics mentioned above are being given to the participating Districts for preparation of papers to be presented on their behalf.
- (ii) The Principal District and Sessions Judges, **Durg/ Balod/ Bemetara/ Kawardha/ Rajnandgaon** may select a team of three Judicial Officers across the ranks or from the rank dealing with the subject and two of them would present and read the papers in English.
- (iii) Each District is allotted 20 minutes time for presentation and 10 minutes extra time for interactive session.
- (iv) Each District shall ensure that the soft copy of presentation is supplied to CSJA before the Seminar **latest by 02/04/2026** so that the same may be placed before Hon'ble Chairperson and other Committee Members. They shall also ensure that six

numbers of hard copies of the presentation are supplied to CSJA within seven days after Seminar.

(v) The minute to minute programme of the Seminar shall be prepared by the Principal District & Sessions Judge, Durg and be sent to CSJA, Bilaspur prior to the date of organization of the Seminar.
